**Jonathan Satter** has a broad and diverse real estate and financial background. Currently he serves as Principal of Compass Realty Companies, a regional realty services firm with offices in South and West Florida. Satter also serves as an independent receiver appointed by the civil court system in matters involving real estate assets. Mr. Satter previously served as Vice President and Senior Operations Officer for the management group of one of the nation's largest real estate investment trusts (REIT) with realty assets exceeding \$7 billion. In this position, Satter was directly responsible for the asset and property management, leasing and marketing, brokerage operations, construction, and risk management of a diverse office, retail, and residential portfolio located throughout the United States. Prior to his position in the investment real estate community, Mr. Satter served as Director of Finance for one of the country's largest specialty development firms. In this position he coordinated financial operations of the firm and served as asset manager for \$200 million in office and retail properties around the country. Mr. Satter started his career with Barnett Banks, Inc., West Palm Beach, FL (now Bank of America), where he served as a Real Estate Credit Administrator servicing commercial and residential loan portfolios. A graduate of Rollins College with a degree in political science, Satter also received his Master of Business Administration from Nova Southeastern University. In July 2005, and again in September, 2006, Satter was appointed by Florida Governor Jeb Bush to serve as a Commissioner of the Health Care District of Palm Beach County where he serves as Vice Chair of the Board, and Chairman of the Finance Committee. In 2007, Satter was chosen by Mayor Lois Frankel to serve on the Board of the West Palm Beach Downtown Development Authority.
